

# AFC Cup Thrills & Omani Delights (4D/3N)

# 4 DAYS/ 3 NIGHTS

## Days 1

#### Arrive in Doha

- Freshen up at your hotel. Jump into the lively **Souq Waqif**, exploring hidden alleys, haggling for treasures, and savoring Qatari coffee. Witness falconry displays, a quintessentially Qatari tradition.
- Dive into the AFC Asian Cup in the evening! Catch a group stage match at one of the state-of-the-art stadiums, soaking in the electric atmosphere and cheering for your team.
- Indulge in a vibrant dinner at a top-notch restaurant like La Sponda or Nobu overlooking the glittering marina.

### Day 2

#### **MUSCAT**

Take an early morning flight to Muscat. Get off check-in at hotel, rest for some time. Proceed for Half Day City Tour of Muscat.

- Visit the Grand Mosque, highlight of the Muscat city.
- Drive along the waterfront Corniche visiting the colorful Muttrah Souq.
- Proceed to visit Bait Al Zubair Museum to have a glimpse of Oman's history.

#### DAY 3

#### Nizwa

- Head to Nizwa Fort and Souq both of which are attractions in their own right. With its massive circular watchtower and interior living spaces,
  this is a great example of an Omani fortification. The fort is surrounded by a sprawling souq, where visitors can spend hours bargaining for
  local pottery, handicrafts and jewelry.
- The wadi and village of Tanuf is a 20-minute drive away from Nizwa Fort. Here you can explore old ruins and walk along the river before setting out for your return to Muscat.

#### DAY 4

#### Jabal Akhdar – Muscat – Departure

- The villages of Saiq, **Wadi Bani Habib** (the village of the old houses) visit to village roose & Al Ain dot the landscape. The villages overlook a spectacular landscape of dramatic peaks, gorges and wadis. The roses of Jabal Al Akhdar fill the air with fragrance when in full bloom (March / April). Rose water is distilled in the homes of the villagers. (It is advisable to wear light comfortable clothing and walking shoes).
- Drop off at Muscat International airport.
