



4 Nights/5 days in Philadelphia & Washington, DC

Arrive at Philadelphia

Morning/Afternoon:

- Arrive in Philadelphia and transfer to your hotel.

Evening:

- The evening is at leisure. Explore nearby surroundings or relax after your journey.

Day 2 - Philadelphia City Tour

Morning:

- Make your way independently to the designated Hop-On Hop-Off tour pick-up point.
- Board an open-top double-decker sightseeing bus. Enjoy live commentary from an expert guide sharing stories of Philadelphia's rich history.
- Start with exploring the Liberty Bell.
- Then head to Independence Hall, followed by Betsy Ross House.

- Stop by Ben's Chili Bowl to try DC's signature dish – The Half-Smoke.
- Overnight stay in Washington, DC.
