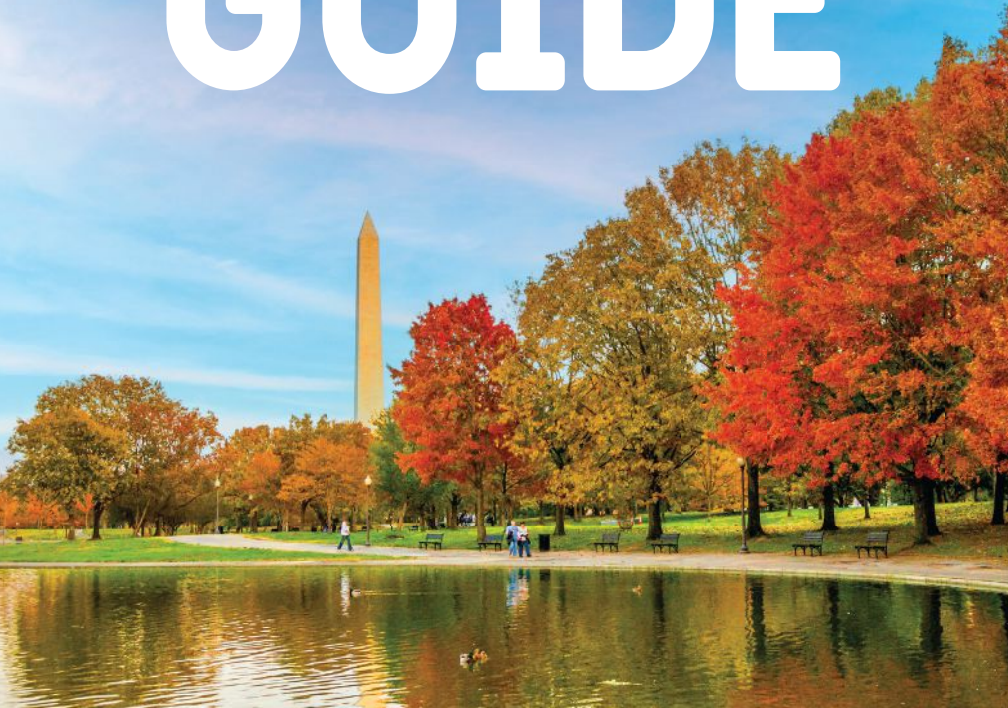

Enjoy marvelous museums, stately memorials and stunning landmarks without paying a cent in DC. For more free things to do, visit washington.org.

NATIONAL GALLERY OF ART

Through East and West Buildings, the most visited art museum in the U.S. in 2022 features work from numerous countries and historical eras. A special exhibition dedicated to Dorothea Lange opens Nov. 5.

LIBRARY OF CONGRESS

The illustrious Thomas Jefferson Building offers free tours, which allow visitors to marvel at Gilded Age architecture, the Library's grand Reading Room and exhibitions filled with essential history.

NATIONAL MUSEUM OF AMERICAN HISTORY

Explore exhibits on American Democracy and entertainment history with artifacts like First Ladies gowns and Dorothy's Ruby Slippers from Oz.

SMITHSONIAN'S NATIONAL ZOO

Tucked alongside quiet Northwest DC neighborhoods, the 163-acre park is home to 2,100-plus animals, including lions, giant pandas, Asian elephants and western lowland gorillas.

NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE AMERICAN INDIAN

Inside, exhibits and public programs share Indigenous peoples' cultures, arts and histories. Outside, the **National Native American Veterans Memorial** honors the service of Native veterans.

LINCOLN MEMORIAL

Featuring a 19-foot-tall, 175-ton statue of our nation's 16th president, the National Mall's crown jewel overlooks the magnificent Reflecting Pool and has the Gettysburg Address and Second Inaugural Address engraved into its walls.

PLANET WORD

Language comes to life at DC's voice-activated museum. Interact with a 22-foot talking wall that reveals the origins of words and visit the Speaking Willow tree, where you can hear murmurs in hundreds of languages.

MILLENNIUM STAGE

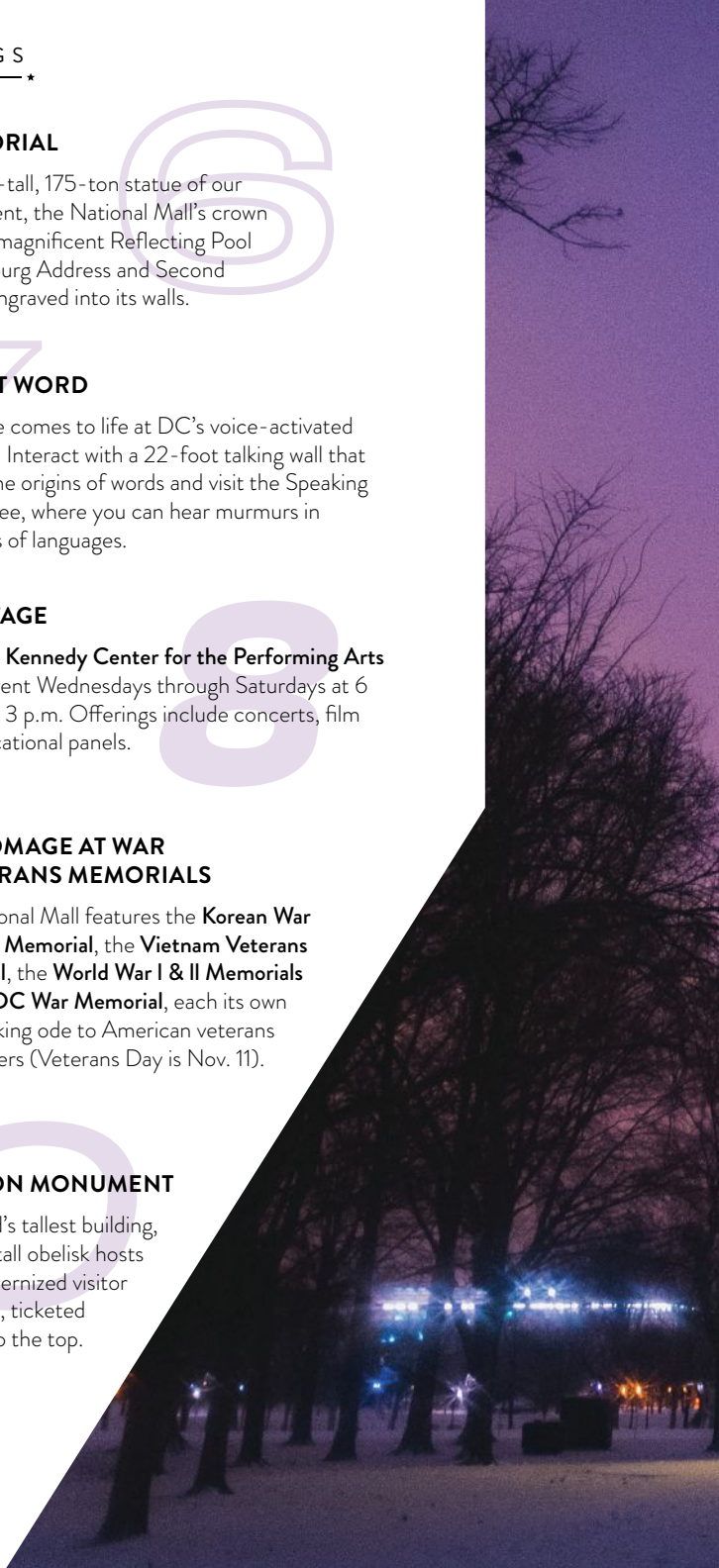
Head to the **John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts** for a free cultural event Wednesdays through Saturdays at 6 p.m. and Sundays at 3 p.m. Offerings include concerts, film screenings and educational panels.

PAY HOMAGE AT WAR & VETERANS MEMORIALS

The National Mall features the **Korean War Veterans Memorial**, the **Vietnam Veterans Memorial**, the **World War I & II Memorials** and the **DC War Memorial**, each its own breathtaking ode to American veterans and soldiers (Veterans Day is Nov. 11).

WASHINGTON MONUMENT

Once the world's tallest building, the 555-foot-tall obelisk hosts tours in its modernized visitor center and free, ticketed elevator rides to the top.
